# **Toulon selects** projects for possible grant

For The Prairie News TOULON - Toulon City parks could see an upgrade if a \$750,000 grant application is approved.

The council met Monday for a special meeting and voted 4-2 to use the \$750,000 to refurbish Toulon's city park and add a splash pad for children. An alternate site for the grant money were the city's baseball fields, located east of the Stark County High School property.

After discussion, the council approved directing the grant money from the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, if awarded, to the city park. Connie Jacobson, Art Nutzhorn, Brandon Simpson and Michael Schott voted "yes" while Donna Lefler and Ryan Kelly voted "no."

The council also passed a motion to give permission to Mayor Larry Hollis to accept Continued on Page 2

# **Officers' actions** 'justified' in Williams death

TOULON - The actions of officers in the shooting death of Rodney G. Williams on Feb. 18 were "legally justified, reasonable and necessary" according to Stark County State's Attorney Caroline Borden Campion.

In a July 28 press release, Borden Campion outlined the events prior to Williams' subsequent shooting and death by law enforcement officers in the early hours of Feb. 18. According to Illinois State Police press releases in February, Williams was killed when "officers from the Henry County Special Operations Squad" attempted to arrest and execute a search warrant at 500-A N. Olive St., in Toulon.

"The following statement details the investigation and the determination that the shooting of Williams, done while Williams was striking an officer with a machete, was legally justified by officers of

Capitol News Illinois Many Illinois drivers who need to renew their license at a Secretary of State facility will have to make an appointment to ensure service starting this fall.

Starting Sept. 1, 44 driver services facilities in medium- to large-sized cities around Illinois will require appointments for driver services – things like renewing a license, updating a license to meet Real ID requirements or taking a driving test. Customers without an appointment may not be guaranteed service.

Vehicle services, like title registration and license-plate sticker renewals, will still be offered to walk-ins.

The facilities impacted by the move to appointmentbased service are in some of the state's most high-traffic lo-

The change in policy is accompanied by a standardization of hours at driver services facilities. All driver services facilities will operate from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Sixteen locations will offer Saturday morning hours from 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., including Peoria. "Our goal is to change the

# WILLIAMS: Family questions use of deadly force

Continued from Page 1 the Henry County Special Operations Squad to prevent death or great bodily harm to others," the press release says.

A wellness check on Williams was performed Feb. 10 at the request of family members.

"Deputies entered Williams' apartment and determined Williams was in his bedroom. Williams would not come out and began swinging a machete out of his bedroom near where emergency personnel were located," according to the press release.

On Feb. 17 charges for aggravated assault were filed against Williams in Stark County Circuit Court, stemming from a Feb. 13 incident. Williams allegedly threatened his landlord Paul E. Porter according to

previous court documentation. Williams had displayed a machete at that time, also.

On Feb. 18, the Henry County Special Operations Squad arrived at approximately 6 a.m. at Williams' apartment to execute the arrest warrant. Williams could be seen in the apartment "through the glass porch front door. He was yelling and holding a machete in a cocked back position," according to the press release.

Police entered the apartment with "a no-knock authority" and found Williams was in a room with a closed door. Police breached the door and Williams allegedly charged at an officer who was standing in the doorway with a shield.

Williams allegedly attacked the Henry County police officer and

damaged the shield with a machete. Williams pulled the shield down, "exposing the deputy's upper torso and attempted to slash him again. At this point, shots were fired by this deputy, another Henry County deputy and a Kewanee police officer."

Williams was taken to Saint Luke Hospital in Kewanee, where he died from multiple gunshot wounds. Williams' family members have stated, "other forces besides lethal forces could have been used that could have prevented this and he'd still be here with us."

Borden Campion wrote in the press release, "Overall, the officers' actions were legally justified, reasonable and necessary to protect the health and safety of the officers, the community of Toulon and citizens of Stark County."






