provides the services.

First Choice Healthcare has three clinics that are located in Colona, Kewanee and Toulon.

"I wish we had dental, that's a future dream," Rediger said. "We have a pharmacy, Toulon Telepharmacy, coming in any day now." Also available at the Toulon

Toulon TIF will pay business \$513,000

For The Prairie News TOULON - The Toulon City Council on Monday approved several Tax Increment Finance payments, including \$513,000 to West Jersey Express.

The council decided on a 50% developer's share for Matt Plumer's West Jersey Express, which has spent \$2 million to restore the former Kraft Cheese plant building on East Main Street. The first payment by Toulon will be in 2027 with the final payment in 2042.

Another \$108,504 in TIF payments was approved for 2025. A portion of that total was to repay the city's general savings for work

done on Stark County School District parking lots near the high school track and baseball diamonds that Potter & Sons constructed. Also, \$16,003 was for a repayment to the water/sewer savings account for the MidCo Diving invoices submitted for inspection, cleaning and other work on Toulon's water-storage tank.

The council also tentatively approved two TIF applications from Tom Pearson's Total Home Services for \$3,397 and \$4,560. Payment awaits a breakdown of labor vs. materials. The city will also pay a 50% developer's share on these two Continued on Page 2

Stark County board passes nine items

For The Prairie News TOULON - The Stark County Board of Supervisors approved nine agenda items during a brief monthly meeting on Tuesday.

Approved were Cheryl Daum's and Stacy Unhold's reappointments to the Stark County Health Board. These are three-year terms from June 1 to May 31, 2028.

A special use permit petition by Dennis Webster of Elmira Township was approved for a helipad for his personal use in landing and taking-off with his helicopter. The 2.2-acre grass pad is in Elmira Township at Part SW1/4 Section 19, and was approved Monday by

both Stark County boards of appeals and zoning appeals.

The board passed an ordinance regulating the development of flood plain areas in Stark County. It was last updated approximately 40 years ago. Passing this ordinance allows the county to receive funding for this item. Bradford, Toulon and Wyoming must also pass this flood plain measure prior to April 23.



Rediger said Toulon's clinic will accept new patients from anywhere. The clinic offers primary care and accepts walk-in visits, for school and sports physicals and labs. X-ray services are not available.

Clinic hours are Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m, though the clinic is closed noon to 12:30 p.m. for lunch. The clinic phone number is (309) 852-3115.

If emergency care is required either during or after hours, the clinic can send a patient to an emergency department nearby such as Kewanee,

Galesburg or Peoria.

The clinic's staff consists of Rediger, Kim Strand in the front office, Family Nurse Practitioner Karol O'Neill and Registered Nurse Laura Schaefer.

The clinic accepts a variety of different forms of payment from patients.

Design firm chosen for **Bishop Hill renovations**

SPRINGFIELD - State Rep. Travis Weaver (R-Edwards) announced on Wednesday that the Chicago-based design firm JLK Architects has been contracted to make detailed plans for renovations of the state-managed Bishop Hill historic site.

The state will spend close to \$1 million on the architectural plans that will serve as a road map for future renovations of the historic site in Henry County. Weaver said JLK will hold a public meeting with community members at some point, possibly in April.






